Jacobs Creek Brut Cuvee \$24.00

Citrus and roasted cashew nut flavours with a soft, crisp and clean finish

Lindauer Brut \$23.00

A wine predominantly made from Pinot Noir that shows great power and body

Lindauer Fraise \$24.00

An added touch of strawberry to this crisp chardonnay and pinot noir flavoured methode traditionnelle

Lindauer Special Reserve \$34.00

A wine predominantly made from Pinot Noir that shows great power and body

Giesen – Marlborough \$31.00

Intense fruit characters in the stone-fruit and tropical spectrum, with a slight nutty oak influence

Nobilo – Poverty Bay \$29.00

Bright fruit flavours and aromas of citrus and tropical fruits

Oyster Bay - \$35.00

Tropical, stonefruit and lively lime citrus flavours, underpinned with a fine, lingering creamy texture

Hurunui River – North Canterbury \$30.00

Clear, crisp with golden colour, fruity and dry with a hint of sweetness

Sauvignon Blanc

Drylands – Marlborough \$36.00

A perfect balance of ripe, sweet fruit and fresh, zesty acidity

Fairleigh Estate – Marlborough \$28.00

Vivaciously distinctive Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc displaying wonderfully herbaceous / gooseberry aromas supporting a beautifully balanced palate

Forrest Estate – Marlborough \$41.00

Bursting with ripe tropical fruits - passionfruit, pawpaw and mango whilst retaining traditional herbal, gooseberry and redcurrant aromas

Hurunui River – North Canterbury \$30.00

Fresh, green & herbaceous, with a crisp, invigorating palate

Nobilo – Marlborough \$31.00

Aromas of lychees, gooseberries and melons with a touch of herbaceousness

Oyster Bay – Marlborough \$37.00

This has ripe tropical fruit with a citrus backbone and a grassy edge on the nose and palate with a zippy finish.

St Helena Pinot Gris – Canterbury \$26.00

A rich complex wine with fresh pear aromas and a nutty dry finish

Villa Maria Private Bin Pinot Gris – East Coast \$33.00

A deliciously fresh, off-dry wine with light, spicy aromas, ripe pear flavours and a fine lingering finish.

Charles Wiffen Riesling – Marlborough \$34.00

Floral, fresh and tangy, with citrusy, limey, pineapple flavours, it's a slightly sweet style, finely balanced for early drinking.

Drylands Dry Riesling – Marlborough \$38.00

Crisp, fresh citrus fruit, which lingers long

Main Divide Riesling – Waipara \$34.00

Super ripe fruit with some botrytis, an opulent floral spiciness and a lemon/lime lengthy finish

Penfolds Rawsons Retreat Cabernet Sauvignon – South Australia \$34.00

Opulent dark berry flavours with a firm structure and rich finish

Taylors Cabernet Sauvignon – Clare Valley \$34.00

Rich concentrated fruit flavours of blackcurrants and cassis along with subtle chocolate and mint

Red Rock - Gravel Pit Red - Merlot Malbec \$42.00

Extremely dark, with ripe black berry fruit and plummy varietal characters with aromas of chocolate

Drylands Pinot Noir – Marlborough \$39.00

Boquet of ripe cherry fruit. Strawberry, cherry and plum flavours meld with earthy, gamey characters and a touch of spice

Torlesse Pinot Noir – Waipara \$34.00

Classic Pinot character, the focus is on balance and elegance

Hope Estate Shiraz – Hunter Valley \$33.00

Plum and earthy spice characters with pepper and berry flavours
